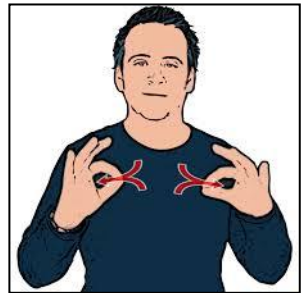
Gardens needed for 'Harnham on the Move' Open Gardens weekend.
