Upgrading the Sound at St George's

Thanks to a generous anonymous donor, NewTech Southern will be upgrading the sound system at St George's between now and Easter. Improvements will include new speakers, new amplifier, new lectern and altar microphones, new radio mikes, and a bluetooth connection to enable music from phones, ipads or laptops to be played through the system.
