Safeguarding

You may have heard on the news about the Independent Inquiry into Child Sexual Abuse for the whole of the Anglican Church in England and Wales. The report highlights the previous practices within the church that have resulted in the abuse of children by clerics and members of the congregation.

The safeguarding of children and vulnerable adults is a priority for Harnham Parish Churches. We take our responsibilities very seriously and work in partnership with the Diocese of Salisbury to ensure that we work in accordance with best practice at all times.

Abuse is detrimental to both the abused and the abuser. As vicar I am aware that abuse can take different forms and can happen to anyone at any time. Just one recent example is the financial abuse that has occurred for elderly residents during lockdown.

More than 2,500 "safeguarding concerns" about children and vulnerable adults were reported to all dioceses in 2018. Although this may sound alarming, it also shows that we are engaged in a culture now that reports abuse which is a positive.
