What is a seder meal?

The Passover Seder is a ritual feast that marks the beginning of the Jewish holiday of Passover. Some Christian theologians believe that it is this meal upon which Jesus' last supper was based. It can give us greater understanding into the symbolism of the time, Jewish traditions, the life of Jesus and Holy Communion. There are different elements to the meal- a plate with different foods and 4 cups of wine! We will use a simple *all age* prayerful service based around this meal and celebrate our fellowship and service to one another as we remember Jesus' last meal.
