

HARVEST COLLECTIONS - RESPONDING TO OUR GENEROUS GOD

Bearing in mind the continuing need for caution regarding Covid-19, and also the dire situation faced by so many Afghan refugees both here and in Afghanistan, please consider responding to God's generosity to us in Harnham in one or more of the following ways, at our service in the PH field on 26th September, or one of our Harvest Festival services on Sunday 3rd October:

- a) Bring tinned or packeted food (**not fresh**), and put it in the box that will be available in both churches, which will then be delivered to **Salisbury Foodbank**, to support Salisbury families in need of emergency support;
- b) Bring toiletries, and put in a separate box that will be in both churches, which will then be delivered to **Salisbury Women's Refuge**, which provides a safe haven for women and children experiencing domestic abuse;
- c) Contribute cash or cheques to a collection, which will be transferred to a charity supporting men, women and children in Afghanistan suffering as a result of the current conflict.
