BELL RINGING

In common with churches across the country, the church bells of at All Saints and St George's will be rung this Saturday 30th October at 6.00pm, as a 'code red warning to humanity' and a sign of hope, on the eve of COP26, the international Climate Change Conference which starts on Sunday in Glasgow. Church bells have traditionally sounded a warning of an impending threat or invasion. As Edward Gildea, the coordinator of this action says, "The current threat from Climate Change is greater than the threat of invasion by the Armada, Napoleon, and Hitler rolled into one, as it is a global threat on a vast, possibly uncontrollable scale, in which the prime enemy is ourselves."
