Rogation Walk - Sunday 22nd May

This is a walk around the Parish boundary of approximately 7 miles during which we reconnect with the land, acknowledging God's blessings on the land and all who live and work in Harnham. Rogation is a time of thanksgiving and supplication. We will be leaving after the 9.30am service at St George's (probably 10.45am) and stopping for lunch in the corner of the fields near the top of Old Blandford Road. We will be returning to All Saints for an afternoon tea followed by a short evensong at 3.30pm.

ANNUAL PAROCHIAL CHURCH MEETING (APCM) and Communion Service Sunday 29th May – 10.00am in the Parish Hall

There will be a short communion service in the Parish Hall at 10.00am, brief comfort break and then the APCM. It is planned to finish as close to midday as possible.
