**Covid guidance for Harnham Parish. As covid cases are on the rise I thought a reminder of What if I feel ill with covid or I have a Positive test?**

You should try to stay at home. Do stay at home for five days after a positive test. Please also wear a mask if around others for the following five days. However, the PCC Standing Committee, would prefer if you do not come to church worship or meetings/ social events until you test negative. Please also tell close contacts that they may have been exposed to COVID-19. You can begin spreading the virus in 48 hours before you have any symptoms or test positive.

### **In our churches and meetings, we will try to ensure:**

Good ventilation and social distancing- Both doors open before service begins and straight as service ends, doors to the hall will be open. Social distancing continues to be a personal choice. All are encouraged to respect other attendees.

Peace -This can be shared and the hand gel used. Please respect other people's desire to keep a distance.

Communion - A face covering is worn by those who administer communion. Communion can be received in both kinds, with the option of wine.

***If you test positive and are at home alone and need urgent help then please do contact the NHS. If you need help with day to day life then please contact clergy or church wardens.***
