**Covid guidance for Harnham Parish.**

**What if I feel ill with covid or I have a Positive test?** You should try to stay at home for five days after a positive test. Please also wear a mask if around others for the following five days. However, the PCC Standing Committee, would prefer if you do not come to church worship or meetings/ social events until you test negative. Please also tell close contacts that they may have been exposed to COVID-19. You can begin spreading the virus in 48 hours before you have any symptoms or test positive.

Good ventilation and social distancing- Both doors open before service begins and straight as service ends, doors to the hall will be open. Social distancing continues to be a personal choice. All are encouraged to respect other attendees.

Peace -This can be shared and the hand gel used. Please respect other people's desire to keep a distance.

Communion - A face covering is worn by those who administer communion. Communion can be received in both kinds, with the option of wine.
