Healthy Safeguarding Cultures Survey

The diocese is committed to maintaining safe, respectful, and supportive environments for all. Your feedback on our current culture and safeguarding practices is invaluable. Throughout November they are asking parishes within Salisbury Diocese to take part in an anonymous survey which should take approximately 5-10 minutes to complete. The purpose of the survey is to understand culture and identify areas of strength and areas for improvement.

We encourage as many people as possible to take part in it, from clergy to PCC members, congregation members and people who have experienced abuse. The survey will remain open until 30th November 2024.
