### Safequarding

General Synod took place over 4 days last week. Amongst other items there was a major discussion about Safeguarding. Bishop Steven writes 'All three houses of Synod voted for an amendment which agreed to outsource the national safeguarding team to an external body. A second independent scrutiny body will also be set up to resolve complaints about church safeguarding. This amendment also goes further in that it commits the Church to more work on how diocesan and cathedral teams could also be moved to this new independent body in the future.'
